

Will of Elizabeth Denson. City of
 Georgia } In the name of God Amen, I
 Wilkeson County } Elizabeth Denson being of sound
 mind and memory, do hereby make, publish
 and declare this to be my last will and
 testament hereby revoking and making void
 all former wills by me at any time her-
 tofore made.

First, I order and direct my Executor
 after my decease as soon as practicable to
 pay off and discharge all my debts, dues,
 and liabilities.

Second, It is my will that the following
 property, to wit: my Dedy. Bred Land, my
 Chace Lot, my Rodgers Land, my Dye Land,
 my Brazell Land, and my Denson Land, Con-
 taining in all 2227 and more or less, said
 lands lying in Bluff and Pleasant Districts
 Wilkes County, said State, be divided into four equal
 shares, and that each of my sons, Elias, J. and
 William A. Denson and my grand son John B. Henry
 have an equal share of my said lands and that
 one of said equal shares shall be equally divided
 between the two children of my deceased son Robert
 A. Denson.

Third, I reserve during my life time my house and
 lot on which I now live, the negro houses and
 one hundred and of land more or less such
 as I may select for farming purposes, I give
 them each the use of said lands on the following
 conditions, to wit: Each this is to pay me yearly for
 my support, sixty two dollars and fifty cents,
 making in all two hundred and fifty dollars
 yearly, the crops on each body of land to be
 under my Control until said annuities are paid
 to me on or before the first day of December
 each year.

Fourth, I give and bequeath to my grand daughter
 Nancy A. Tolson two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and
 provided she is not living and has no child
 living at my death the same shall revert
 back to my Estate and be equally divided between
 my other heirs hereinafter mentioned.

Fifth, I give and bequeath to my grand son John
 B. Denson two (\$10.00) dollars

Sixth, It is my will that all property of mine
 not mentioned to be here divided all of my stock

of every third Mayan. My wife, farming Town &c
be equally divided between my son Elias J and William
H. Dudson.

Second. It is my will that should either of my
children or grand children herein mentioned die
leaving no children nor grand children living the
amount given them or either of them, revert back
to my estate and be equally divided among my other
heirs herein mentioned.

Eighth. I hereby appoint my son William H. Dudson
Trustee for the children of my deceased son Robert H
Dudson, with power to use said property any way
he may think best for said children.

Ninth. I hereby appoint my son Elias J. Dudson
Executor to this my last will and testament,
signed, sealed, and delivered in presence of us
March 15th 1894
