 blessed be god do this 22nd day of October in the year of our
 lord 1829 Make and publish this my last will &
 testament in manner following that is to say first I
 give & bequeath to my beloved wife my negro man
 Harry my horse James my saddle & bridle also all my
 tools & farming utensils of every description
 I further give my wife Elizabeth Clowell two feather
 beds & furniture of every description I also leave my
 afforesaid wife it negre woman Chaney during her
 natural life and after her death I give the said
 woman Chaney and her increase from this time to my
 two daughters namely Cety & Peggy to them and their
 heirs for ever to be equally divided at my afforesaid
 wifes decease I also give my daughter Cety one negre Boy
 Ben one feather Bed & furniture I further give to
 my daughter Peggy one negre Boy named Sam one
 feather bed & furniture I give to my son Richard Clowell
 one negre boy named Lewis to him and his heirs
 forever (Nam) I give to son John Clowell negre man Perry one
 negre Tom // to him and his heirs forever I also give to
 my son John one horse named Struff
 Then I leave to my afforesaid wife all my lands and
 plantation whereon I now live during her natural
 life and after my said wifes decease I give to my son
 John all my lands of every description to him and his
 heirs forever I further give him one bed and furniture
 Then I give to my afforesaid wife all my stock of hogs of every
 description Cattle and Sheep I further give to my beloved
 wife Elizabeth all my crop of every description
 Then I leave to my daughter Elizabeth Hollingsworth one negre
 woman named Cety & three children during her natural
 life and after her decease the afforesaid negre woman
 and three children with all their increase to be equally
 divided between my afforesaid daughters children
 and her husband Stephen Hollingsworth Then
 I give to my daughter Nancy Barden one negre
 woman named Abby and her two children to her
 and her heirs forever Then I give to my daughter
