give & bequeath unto my wife Serenice
one Negro woman named Minda aged about twenty
three to have & to hold said negroes together
with the increase of said Minda which
may proceed from the body of the said negro
Minda from this time forward during the
natural life of said Serenice my beloved wife
I also by this my last will & testament do
give & bequeath unto my beloved wife
Serena with that tract or parcel of land
known & distinguished as Lot 6 to one Thomas
and four (104) in the Northeast corner
of originally worn now Thomas County
on which my plantation now is together
with the appurtenances thereunto belonging
and also the farming tools on said plantation
to have and to hold said plantation
together with all & singular of the appurtenances
and tools & appurtenances thereunto belonging
during the natural life of my beloved
wife as aforesaid
I also by this my last will & testament do
give & bequeath unto my beloved wife
one one horse wagon and two mules
and two cows and their calves and all
my house hold & kitchen furniture
to have & to hold the same during the
natural life of my beloved as aforesaid
it is my desire that all of the aforesaid
property viz. the said negro man &

and said negro woman and her increase if any
the appraised bench table wagon horse horse tools
and kitchen furniture after the death of my
beloved wife, be and be equally divided
amongst my heirs at law and by this my last
will & testament do direct that the property
specified above as appraised after the death
of my beloved wife be and be equally divided
amongst my beloved children and their heirs
at law.

I do by this my last will & testament appoint
Archibald McMillan & Moses Daniel both of the
State and County aforesaid Executors of this
my last will & testament and do desire that
they the said Moses Daniel & Archibald
McMillan take the said negroes and other
property specified as above into their keeping
forthwith upon the prebute of this my last
will & testament and deliver them into the
actual possession of My beloved wife be and
as aforesaid or so soon as possible after wages
have according to law in such case made or
provided for her the said be and as aforesaid
be and as aforesaid during the natural life
of the said be and as aforesaid my beloved wife
And do further more by this my last will &
testament desire that my heirs & administrators may
have the said negroes to wit the man Sam
& woman Minter and the children that she said
Minter they hereafter have together with
the land and appurtenances thereto belonging
to wit the bench table kitchen furniture wagon
& horses as appraised in the peaceable and
undisturbed possession of my executors herein
named to wit Moses Daniel & Archibald McMillan
or if the said property shall have passed into
the possession of my beloved wife be and
as aforesaid be and as aforesaid without
making it subject to administration
