

State of Georgia In the Name of God, Amen,
Group County I Alexander Speer of the County and State
above named being of sound and disposing mind
and memory but remembering that if dust I am and into dust I must
return do make my last Will and Testament in words and figures following
to wit!

Item 1st I die in confident hope of a blessed resurrection having made an abiding
faith in the atoning merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour, I desire to be buried
in a decent manner as a Christian

Item 2^d After the payment of my debts I bequeath to my son C. H. Speer my negro
boy named Mike. All the remainder of my property, Real and personal
Money, Notes and Claims in action that I now own or may hereafter be entitled
to at my death I do give and bequeath to my wife Caroline J. Speer and
my two children Mary E. Speer and Francis J. Speer in equal portions
share and share alike hereby making them the residuary legatees of my
Estate

Item 3^d Should my Executors deem it necessary or advisable I give them power to
sell my house and lot and furniture and provisions if not needed and
I empower them to sell publicly or privately as they shall deem best the
proceeds to be the property of the said three residuary legatees

Item 4th The property I desire to be managed by my Executors for the support and
comfort of said wife and two children in common until one shall arrive
at age of twenty then equally divided, should either one of my said chil-
dren Mary E. or Francis J. die before arriving at age or marrying I direct
that the surviving child shall take the property of the one so dying, all
the property bequeathed or in any event coming to my daughter by reason
of the terms of this Will I give to the sole and separate use of her that
said Mary E. Speer for life and at her death to her children and in
no event to be subject to the debts, contracts or liabilities, any husband

Item 5th If deemed by my Executors to be necessary for the proper and safe
government of my negro and the management of the Estate to sell or
dispose of any of my negro I give full power to do so either privately or
publicly as they shall deem best, and the proceeds to be invested to her
and become part of the Estate and for my said wife and my two children
as above, Intest in any of all which I have hereunto set my hand
and seal and published and declared the foregoing as my last
Will and Testament the 9th day of January 1861 signed sealed
published and declared in presence of us and who attest the
same in the presence of the Testator
