Georgia I now all men by these presents  
Troup County that I Benjamin Rhodes, of the  
County of Troup and State of Georgia do by  
these presents make appoint and confirm this  
as my will and testament in the following word  
tooth-

First - I will and bequeath my soul to the  
God who gave it.

Secondly - That my Executors shall have me  
buried decently, and pay out of my Estate all  
funeral expenses

Thirdly That my debts shall all be paid that  
are legal out of Estate both personal or real  
Fourthly That after all my debts are paid my  
Executors shall pay to Susan C Rhode, the sum  
of five dollars in money and to Caroline Rhode  
the sum of five dollar in Money, they being my  
wife and daughter.

Fifthly. That all the residue or remaining  
portion of my Estate (if any there should be)  
both real and personal I give and bequeath to  
my brother John Rhode, Children to be equally  
divided betwixt all the heirs legitimate of his  
body whether living or posthumous, and that the  
the said John Rhode, have the use of said  
property as guardian or trustee for his children  
during his life or pleasure

Sixthly That Lawrence Gahagan of the  
County of Troup and State of Georgia and  
Hercykeah Et Brown of the County of Troup and  
State of Georgia be and I do hereby declare them  
and each of them My lawfull Executors and  
they or either of them and hereby authorised &  
required to execute this my last will and  
testament, and distribute my Estate to the  
purposes and to the persons above named for
