Deed

I peremptorily order that my just debts be paid of every kind. I then give unto my beloved wife Patsy Cook, the tract of land wherein I now live known by the name of the McCube tract containing three hundred and twenty nine acres more or less with all the stock of hogs on the place, ten head of Choice Cattle, the stock of Sheep, two Choice Horses, and two wheel Carriage the parsonage and kitchen furniture. My request I wish to be paid out annually, except so much as is necessary to wait on the family and the family to be maintained out of the proceeds of the same also my children to be educated from the same. Whatever of kind property there may be at my wife's death I wish to be equally divided among my children. My cross tract of land containing 142 acres adjoining the said McCube tract one lot of land in Walker fourth section seventh district number 186. I wish paid by my Executors on a credit of one and two years for the benefit of my heirs also the balance of my parsonage property I wish paid by my Executors for the benefit of my heirs I appoint my friend John Sumner my sole Executor of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and this fifth day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty five.

A Codicil to my last Will and Testament
