

State of Georgia? In the name of God Amen:
Group County I Charles W. Broome of Said State and
County being of Sound and disposing mind
and memory and knowing the uncertainty of human life
and being desirous of disposing of my property after death in
such way as I may prefer do make publish and declare this
my last Will & Testament.

Item 1st It is my will and desire after my death that any body be buried in a
decent and Christianlike manner & suitable to my condition &
circumstances in life.

Item 2nd It is my will that all my just debts be paid as soon after my death
as possible and I hereby direct my Executor (hereinafter named) to
use all commodable diligence in so doing.

Item 3rd After the payment of my debts and all necessary funeral expenses &
& Costs of Administration it is my will that the Balance of
my property and Estate of whatever kind or Character I may
own at the time of my death including Lands, negroes, money,
notes, accounts & choses in action & every thing else shall be
equally divided among my Sister Mary Jane Broome and
my Brothers John R. Broome, George W. Broome & James A.
Broome and no one else, Share and Share alike.

Item 4th It is my will and desire & I hereby direct that if either or any of my
Said Brothers or said Sister shall wish to buy any of the Lands
I may own at the time of my death that he or she shall do so
at such prices as any three disinterested friends shall say the
same is worth said friends to be selected by my Executor and
the Brother or Sister desiring to make such purchase.
And it is furthermore my will & direction that my Executor
(hereinafter named) shall have full power and authority to
sell and dispose of any and all of the Lands which I may
own at my death without any order from the Court
& at such time and place and upon such terms as he shall
deem best either at public outcry or privately according to
his best discretion and I do hereby give him the same power
with regard to the sale of any other property which it may
be necessary for him to sell either for the purpose of division
or payments of debts.

Item 5th I nominate and appoint my beloved Brother John R. Broome
Executor to this my last Will and Testament with full confidence
in his integrity & that he will execute the same to the best
of his ability. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal.
