 by my Executors herein after to be named.

 desire that all of my Estate shall be equally di-
 vided between my Son-in-law Edmund Jackson
 of Monroe County in this State and the heirs of
 Chappell Stage of the State of Alabama and my
 Son Edmund S. Harris of the County & State first
 above written and Brittain L. Harris of the State
 of Alabama.
 Item fourth- I do hereby nominate and appoint
 my beloved Son Edmund S. Harris my Sole Executor
 to carry into full effect this my last will and
 testament.
