This indenture made the third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between David Smith of the County of Gauch of the one part and Meriman Harman of the County of Meriwether of the other part - Witnesseth that the said David Smith for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Meriman Harman his heirs and assigns all that tract or lot of Land lying and being in the seventh District of Milledgeville Gauch said Meriwether County known by number one hundred and Twenty Three in said District and County do have and to hold the said tract or lot with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the said Meriman Harman his heirs and assigns or in any wise appertaining with the remainder and remains due to his heirs and assigns unto the said David Smith his heirs and assigns in fee simple and the said David Smith his heirs and assigns against the said David Smith his heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons shall and will warrant and defend by virtue of these presents - In Witness whereof the said David Smith hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written
