both as respects myself that I should make a disposition

blessed me do therefore make this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me
1st Item - I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and Christianlike manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life my soul I trust
shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope
for Eternal Salvation through the merits and atone-
ment of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
whose religion I have professed and as I humbly
trust and enjoyed.

2nd Item - I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid without delay by my Executor herein-
after appointed as I am unwilling my Creditors
should be delayed in their rights Especially as there
is no necessity for delay

3rd Item - I desire that my property should be
sold and debts collected

4th Item - I give and bequeath to my Brother
Jesse Boswell all my effects after my death is
paid to him freely

5th Item - I hereby constitute and appoint

my worthy friend William Danson Jr Executor of this
my last will and testament this the 20th February
1851
