Troup County Wills 1832-1848
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I Edwin Castleberry of the County of Troup & State of Georgia being sick in body yet sound in mind and knowing it is appointed for man once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament viz:

1st I give my soul into the hands of god who gave it and my body to the dust from whence it came.

2nd It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid as also my funeral expences.

3rd I give and bequeath to my brothers Warren F. Castleberry and Allen Castleberry and also to my sisters Angelina Slaughter, Louisa Webb Emily Cameron and Lucinda Thornton twenty to each as above named to be paid by my Executor out of my estate.

4th I further give and bequeath to my beloved Father Edward Castleberry all the balance of my Estate both real & personal.

5th I do further nominate ordain & appoint my Father Edward Castleberry my true and lawful Executor to carry into execution this my last will and testament. 18th Oct 1837
