are hereby appointed commissioners to appraise said
estate & that the Executor return an inventory and
appraisal of the same within three months from

and as I humbly trust enjoyed for fifty two years
Item 2nd) I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid without delay by my Executors herinafter
named as I am unwilling my creditors should be
delayed in their rights especially as there is no necessity
for delay

Item 3rd) I give and bequeath to John Post or his
children the sum of five dollars

Item 4th) I give and bequeath to the children of
John Post deceased the sum of five dollars

Item 5th) I give and bequeath to the children of
Samuel Post deceased the sum of five dollars

Item 6th) I give and bequeath to Alice Morris or her children the sum of ~~one hundred~~^{Troup County Wills, Book B} dollars

Item 7th) I give and bequeath to my faithful servant Jack after all the debts of the estate are paid the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars and the balance to be divided equally among them all Jack Sidney Silver Sarah Betty Joseph and Henry.

Item 8th) I hereby constitute and appoint my much esteemed friends George T. Haraldson and R. C. Boyd Executors to this my last will and testament this July the 25th 1855

 my heirs as I shall hereinafter name
 Item the third I will and bequeath the following Cash
 legacies as special to wit to the children of my deceased
 son John three hundred Dollars to my son William
 Seven hundred Dollars & to my daughter Martha J
 Speer Seven hundred Dollars
