 Item 3rd) I give and bequeath to John Post or his
 children the sum of five Dollars
 Item 4th) I give and bequeath to the children of
 Mrs Post deceased the sum of five dollars
 Item 5th) I give and bequeath to the children of
 Samuel Post deceased the sum of five dollars

Item 6th I give and bequeath to Alex Morris or her children the ^{Tropo County Wills, Book B, 1849-1888} sum of five dollars

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my faithful servant Jack after all the debts of the estate are paid the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars and the balance to be divided equally among them all Jack Sidney Siller Isaac Betty Joseph and Hainey

Item 8th I hereby constitute and appoint my much esteemed friends Jesse B Haraldson and R C Boyd Executors to this my last Will and Testament this July the 25th 1855

ure for furnishing her bed room as she may want all of
which is to remain at the place where she may be living at
the time of her decease & belong to the family with whom
she may be living now contemplated to be with my daughter
Martha & I shew also I will & bequeath to my wife during
her lifetime my negro girl Mary to wait on her as a
constant attendant & at her death said negro and her
increase if any to be equally divided between such of
my heirs as I shall hereinafter name
Item the third I will and bequeath the following Cash
legacies as special to wit to the children of my deceased
son John three hundred Dollars to my son William
Seven hundred Dollars & to my daughter Martha &
I shew Seven hundred Dollars
