I Robert Frazier being of sound disposition
and memory and knowing it is appointed for
all men to die have thought proper to make this
my last will and testament,

First, - I will and desire that all my just
debts should be paid -

Second - I give unto my wife Rachael
Frazier, during her life or widowhood all
the property of which I am possessor both
real and personal to be used & controlled
by her in the manner and way she and
her brother John Shank may think proper
and best for my Estate.

Third - At the marriage of my
said wife Rachael I will and desire that
all my property be equally divided among
my children and wife Rachael in case
she marry.

Fourth - I do hereby constitute nominate
and appoint my loving wife Rachael Frazier
John Shank and Jerry Frazier Executors
and Executors to this my last will and
testament.
