I Green Cofield of The State and County aforesaid of Middle age and now afflicted and knowing that I must soon or later depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make distribution of the property which a kind Providence has blessed me I do therefore make this my last will and testament thereby revoking all others heretofore made by me
Item first I desire that my body should be buried in a decent and Christian like manner according to my circumstances
Item second I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay as there is no reason why there should be any delay
Item third I desire that my estate be kept together during the natural life or widow hood of my wife or until my estate should become of age If my wife should marry I desire that my entire estate should be valued by Commissioners appointed by the Court for that purpose and be distributed in share drawn out and the remainder to remain together until the eldest child becomes of age then the estate to be appraised and his or her distributive share drawn out and so on until they all of age and then their distributive share of my entire estate
Item fourth I desire that my executor should sell all the lands owned by me in the State of Alabama or any other species of property

Or uncontrollable by my executors this to be done publicly or privately at their discretion
 Item fifth. I will and desire that in the event my wife Mary Jane should marry the property then willed to her should not be subject to the debts or control of any future husband or husbands but to be saved and controlled by her and disposed of at her discretion
 Item sixth. I will and desire that the property willed by me to my daughters Mary M. Emmer & Martha Ann Cornelia should not be subject to the debts of any husband and in the event they or either of them should die without bodily heirs the property to revert back to my living children

Item seventh. I desire that if either of my sons die without bodily heirs the property willed to them by me to revert back to my living children
 Item eighth. I desire that all my children should have a liberal English education but in the event that any of them should desire a classical education the extra expense to be paid out of his distributive share

Item ninth. I will and desire that my entire estate be equally divided between my wife Mary Jane and my four children Mary M. E. Thomas J. John & Martha A. C. as directed in the foregoing

Item tenth. I do hereby constitute and appoint my Beloved Brother Uriah Coffield and my well beloved wife my Executor and Executor and Executrix to this my last will and Testament this 9th day of May 1859.
