Troup County Wills 1832-1848

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Item 5th After the payment of my just debt, and the special bequest to my beloved brother James R Walker in the manner herein before described it is my will and desire that all of my Estate both real & personal not herein before disposed of shall be divided equally between my beloved brothers Sisters (to wit), James R Walker, Beverly Walker, John Walker & Henry Walker & Rebecca Harwell formerly Rebecca Walker, Mary Warren formerly Mary Walker, Elizabeth Morgan formerly Elizabeth Walker and Nancy Smith formerly Nancy Walker.

Item 6th I hereby constitute & appoint James R Walker, Beverly Walker, John Walker & Henry Walker my Executors to carry this my last Will & Testament into execution.

In solemn testimony whereof I have hereto set my hand & affixed my Seal this the fifteenth day of May eighteen hundred and thirty eight (1838)
