

The Last Will & Testament of Henry Walston dec^d

Georgia } January 18th 1848
 Group County } I Henry Walston being of sound
 mind do make this my last will and testament.
 First I will that all my just debts be paid.
 Secondly I will that my son James W.
 Walston have the entire amount that he owes
 me and five dollars out of my Estate besides
 and I also will that my son Henry Walston
 have the entire amount that he owes me of five
 dollars more out of my Estate. and
 Thirdly - I will that the heirs of John Walston
 my son have five dollars divided amongst them
 and I relinquish all my claims against the
 Estate of John Walston - and
 Fourthly - I will that the remainder of my Estate
 at my death be sold with the Exception of our
 bed and furniture that is for my wife Mary
 during her life time and at her death that is
 to be sold and the interest of the money aris-
 ing from the sale of my property is to support
 my wife for life time or so much thereof as
 shall be sufficient for a good support and
 at her death I will that the remainder of my
 Estate be equally divided between my children
 as follows Benjamin S. Walston, William Walston
 and Gilman Walston and the heirs of Joshua
 Walston deceased is to have his share and my
 daughter Elizabeth Williams and my daughter
 Mary Canthly and my daughter Sarah
 Cobb each to receive an equal share -
 Fifthly - I will that Gilman Walston and
 Jonathan Kell act as my Executors to carry
 this my will into effect and that they have
 power to sell the whole of my Estate without
 having any appraisement or having to get
 an order of Court to sell the same and when
 they sell that they make a return to the Court
 of the entire amount of the sale

in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & forty
at the residence of Samuel S. Sivill a married
man before and at the time of his death a sane
time before his death in perfect possession of his
mental faculties he called upon us to witness
and take notice of what he was about to say
that it had been his intention to make his will
in writing and dispose of his property some time
before but as it was not convenient for him to
do so at the time he had neglected it since -
now wished us to understand that his will &
desire was that all his Estate both real and
personal should be kept together in common as
my children may arrive at full age that
they shall have such portions of my Estate
my wife Jane Sivill shall ~~have~~ have the
from my said Estate after clothing, boarding
educating my children and such other expenses
may be necessary for the use of the family, the
control of management to be continued until my
youngest child shall arrive at full age - I then
desire an equal division of all my Estate both
real and personal between my wife Jane Sivill and
my children and that he desired that his wife
Jane Sivill to see that his desires in this regard
shall be fully carried out in to effect immediately
after which he died this 12th April 1849
