 a disposition of the property with which a kind
 Providence has blessed me I therefore make this my
 last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling
 all others heretofore made by me

(Item first) I desire and direct that my body be buried
 in a decent Christian like manner suitable to my
 circumstances and condition my soul I trust shall return
 to rest with God who gave it as I hope for eternal
 salvation through the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus
 Christ

(Item second) I desire and direct that all my just debts
 be paid without delay by my Executrix herein after mentioned
 named as I am unwilling my Creditors should be delayed
 of their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay

(Item third) I give and devise to my beloved Sister Sarah of
 Palmer my Lots of Land numbers not known in the
 Seventh District of Lump Containing two hundred and
 one & one quarter acres more or less wherein I now reside
 with all the rights members and appurtenances to said
 Lots of Land in any wise appertaining or belonging
 free from all charges or limitation whatever to her
~~and her heirs~~ own proper use benefit and behoef from
 with full power to dispose of the same at any time
 She may think proper also give and bequeath to
 my sister in the same unreserved manner the
 farming utensils used on and belonging to said
 plantation of every description whatever two mules
 and horse all my stock of cattle yoke of Oxen and
 ox Cart Buggy and harness wheat oats corn and fodder
 My stock of hogs all of my household and Kitching
 furniture of every description also all my ready
 money Notes and accounts in short every thing belonging
 to me in any manner whatever all without reserve
 or limitation

(Item fourth) I give and bequeath to my beloved
 Sister my Negro man Peter about sixty years old
 My Negro man Tom about twenty six years old
 My Negro woman Letty about fifty years old
 My Negro girl Alice about twelve years old all
 without reserve or limitation to ~~her~~ ^{them} ~~and her heirs~~
 to dispose off as she may think proper

(Item fifth) I constitute and appoint my beloved
 Sister Sarah J Palmer Executrix to this my last will
 and Testament this March the 14th 1861
