 to be interred in a decent and Christian like manner

Item 2^d It is my wish that my Wife Jane C Beasley take charge of the whole of
 my Property both personal and Real and that she use and manage the same
 for her own and my Childrens benefit, as she may think best for her and
 my Childrens interest, during her lifetime or widowhood and should she
 marry or die it is my wish that the property be equally divided between my
 Wife and my Children share and share alike, and that my Children have
 Guardians appointed to take charge of and manage their portion of my
 Estate

Item 3^d I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved Wife Jane C Beasley my
 Sole Executrix to use and manage my effects in any way she may
 think best for the interest of herself and my Children
