Fourth I devise and direct that all my just debts be paid by my Executors hereinafter named without delay.

Item Second I desire and direct that all my Estate both real and personal of every description whatever not herein otherwise disposed of remain in the hands of my Wife for the purpose of raising and educating my minor children until my youngest child marries or becomes of legal age or until my Wife's death or marriage.

My daughter Matilda Phelps has received the amount of eight three dollars, my son in law Isaiah C. Hardy in right of his wife Ann ninety dollars & 75 cents my daughter Sidney Watkins seventy four dollars, my daughter Martha McWharney seventy seven dollars 75 cents my daughter Oreny Murphy ~~Eighty three~~ thirty seven dollars, my son Thomas Sixty Six dollars 25 cents, my son William eighty three dollars, I desire that each one of my other children when they marry or arrive at legal age receive a bed and furniture a cow or a calf and a saddle, and my sons a horse each all at their value

the fourth Whenever my youngest child marries or arrives at legal age or at the death of my Wife which ever event takes place first I desire and direct that all my Estate both Real and personal be sold and equally divided amongst all my Children including the advancements to each of them

The fifth I desire and direct in case my Wife should marry before either of the events mentioned in Item fourth then that all my Estate be sold and equally divided amongst all my Children and her and including the advancements.

Now Sixth I Constitute and appoint my son William Glaze and my son in Law John D. McElhany Executors to this my last Will and Testament with full power to buy or sell any thing that may be necessary for carrying on the farm or for the interest of the Estate also with full power to sell any part of my Real Estate and the whole or if it they think best in case my family wishes to remove John Glaze Seal
