Item 3rd My will and desire is that after my death
all my property of every description and character
and all evidences of debts due me after paying
what I may owe is to be kept together and in
the possession of my beloved and affectionate wife
Mary Fremble and for her use support and
maintenance during her natural life and after
her death to be distributed as hereafter named
Item 4th My will and desire is that after the
death of my beloved and affectionate wife that
my Executors make each of my legal heirs equal
in what I may have heretofore and hereafter
given them and which I have charged them
with on my accounts against my children for
distribution and gift
Item 5th After the death of my beloved and
affectionate wife I give and bequeath to my
affectionate daughter Sarah House and her children
by Sarnata Pace the one sixth part of my
Estate
Item 6th My will and desire is that the balance
of my Estate after providing for or distributing
and carrying in to effect the foregoing items
to be equally divided between my affectionate
