Item 1st I in the first place give my body to be returned to its mother earth and resign my soul to the God that brought it into existence

Item 2nd I do hereby give & bequeath unto my dear beloved son James Cook Five dollars in cash to be paid by the Executor

Item 3rd I do hereby give unto my dear beloved son Jimmie Cook five dollars

Item 4 I do hereby give & bequeath unto my son Horatio Cook one third part of all and singular my goods money & effects of my whole estate real & personal which I may be possessed of after paying my just debts and each bequest as well fully & set forth in this my last will & testament And also the said Horatio Cook by my sole and legal Executor of this my will for which purpose I appoint him this day in full view of the law in said Cases made & provided

Item 5th I do hereby give & bequeath unto my dear daughter Amanda Cook the sum of five dollars in cash

Item 6th I do hereby give & bequeath unto my beloved son John Cook the sum of five dollars in cash

Item 7 I do hereby give and bequeath unto my dear beloved son Beverly Cook the balance or remainder two thirds of all my goods money & effects of my whole estate both real and personal let it consist of what it is in away after said debts & bequests as set forth in the terms of this my will

Where of I have this day before these witnesses set forth in plain terms my will & now acknowledging the same & have set my name & affixed my seal the day and date above written
