It is my Will and desire that my niece Elizabeth, Bars have and hold the property that I gave her when I first came to Georgia to wit, a bed & furniture and a negro girl named Judah together with all her increase from the time my said niece came into the possession of her to do with her as she may think proper I hope my Nephew James M Hill is satisfied with the provision I have already made for him and which he now has in his own hands received and enjoyed. I also hope niece Polly Ann Parkan is satisfied with the provision I have already in times past made for her and which she has received in her own hands

I give and bequeath to my Grand Niece Mary Ann Green daughter of Mary Ann Green formerly Mary Ann Hill and Frederick I mean One Thousand dollars in the Note which I now hold against her father the said Frederick I Green

I give and bequeath to my Grand Nephew John I Hill the note I now hold against him for six hundred and eighty dollars or some amount near that, provided and with this condition that out of said Note shall be deducted by the said John I Hill all medical services and medicines of whatever kind rendered and administered to me and mine during my life and the said John I Hill shall not otherwise receive pay for said medicines and medical services. I hereby confirm the gift already made to said John I of a negro man Charles and also of a negro man Bonds already in his possession.

I begone a hope that my Grand Niece Elizabeth I Hillman is satisfied with what I have already given to her and of which she has already entered upon the enjoyment and I also hope my Grand Niece Martha R and Grand Nephew Allen C Hill are satisfied with what I have already given them and upon the enjoyment of which they have already entered

I give and bequeath to my Great Grand Niece Mary Ann Hill and to

I give and bequeath to my Grand Nephew Benjamin H Still my negro
man Albert of Alfred, my negro woman Charity and their child William
together with all the other property goods chattles lands and Tenements rights and

may be possessed except only what is hereinabove disposed of to him and
his heirs forever on account of my affection for him and because of the
continued affection kindness and attention of him and his family towards me
through life
