make a distribution of the property

blessed me. I do therefore make this
my last will and Testament thereby
revoking all others heretofore made by me.

First
and I desire that my body be buried in a
decent and Christian like manner

Second I desire and direct all my just debts
be paid without delay as there is no
other reason why they should not.

Third I do will and bequeath to my son
Wm Glep. one fourth of my entire
estate after the payment of my just
debts and all necessary expenses the
same not subject to the payment of
of his old debts and I appoint James
N Estes Trustee to manage and control
the same and the said Wm to have
all the benefit of the said legacy. And
at his death to go to his children if
any. And if he should die without
heirs the property to revert back to the
heirs named in this will

Fourth I do will and bequeath the remaining
three fourths of my Estate to be equally
divided between my Daughter Catherine Perry
my son James W. Glep. and my said
Grandsons Joseph Ariah Glep. and
Gideon Ariah Glep. the sons of Warren
W. Glep. because the two being entitled
to one distributive share

Fifth I do hereby constitute and appoint my
much esteemed friend James N Estes
my Executor to this my last will
and Testament this the 9th day of June 1858
