Harris of the County of Chatham and State aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind, and memory, and of ordinary health of body, knowing the uncertainty of life and certainty of death do make publick and declare this my last will and testament revoking all other Wills which I may have made heretofore, in substance and form as follows

Item 1st I will my body to the grave to be interred at such place, and manner as shall best suite the taste and convenience of my beloved husband; and my sole to God who gave it knowing that he who doth all things well will render to those of followers who shall continue faithful to the end a rich reward beyond the skies.

Item 2nd It is my will that my beloved husband keep during his lifetime, the whole or any part of my household or kitchen furniture, he may desire to have, I likewise give, and bequeath to him during his lifetime my negro man Polie, woman Sarah, and at his death, I desire that the said negro Polie & Sarah and their increase shall be given to my sister Frances B. Douglass for her own proper behoof & benefit free from the claim or claims of any and every other person forever in fee simple. I also will to my beloved husband during his lifetime my pleasure carriage and at his death I desire that he shall give it to such of my relations as he may think proper I also give to him for ever my primers silver forks with my names some engraved upon them It is my will that my beloved husband shall have and control the whole of my money or notes which are not bearing after disposed of and that he shall pay the legal interest annually to my two neices Low & Fanny Stanley and at the death of my husband it is my desire that the whole of the money and notes above mentioned shall be equally divided share and share alike between Low & Fanny & Thomas children of my brother Matthew H. Mosley.

Item 3^d To my sister Martha I give one thousand dollars and an equal share of my personal effects with my sister Sara Douglass and an equal share of my household and kitchen furniture with my brother Matthew H. Mosley and my sister Frances B. Douglass share and share alike and I desire that my sisters Low & Douglass shall divide and partition to each one his or her respective share.

Item 4th To my sister Frances B. Douglass in addition to the legacy already given her in the 2nd and third Item of this will, I also give her one thousand dollars for her own proper use behoof & benefit free from the claim or claims of any and every other person forever and my two just silver water

Jan 5th I give to my nephew Rober Douglass my negro boy Henry eldest son of Lawrence forever in fee simple, to my niece Emma Coulter to her and Childrens forever free from all claim or claims of any and every other person two thousand dollars now in hands of her husband James Coulter To my niece Rebecca Douglass I give two silver fruit baskets one small silver waiter and silver Saddle two atomiums and my new wood Attu Cha

Jan 6th To my nephew Dr Joseph Jones I give my negro boy Randol ph and my ornamental bed Room and to his daughter Martha Jones I give my negro man Robert my silver Tea set consisting of Tea & Coffee Pot Cream pitcher Sugar Dish and Slop Ball and a large Silver Cup to his second daughter Laura Jones I give eleven hundred dollars now in the hands of Dr Joseph Jones her father for her own proper use and benefit free from the claims or claims of any and ~~any~~ other person for ever

Jan 7th To the orphan children of Samuel Jones dec I give my negro man Jeff, and one thousand dollars to be received and managed for them by Dr Joseph Jones to Martha Trudely I give my negro man Lawrence and his wife Jennie and their children Charlotte Ellen Jane and Mary to her and her children for ever in fee simple

Jan 8th To my niece Kitty Jones I give five hundred dollars in money one dozen silver handled knives one dozen silver forks and two of my El Plantings viz Snow seen and trees of a Lake

Jan 9th To my niece Mary Duggs I give five hundred dollars in money one dozen silver handled knives and a silver Buttin Dish and Stand

Jan 9th I give to my Brother Matthew F Mosley my negro man Newben & Anny his wife during his lifetime and at his death it is my will that they be equally divided between his children, Thomas Fannie Mosley Share and Share alike I give to Joseph Mosley my negro boy Johnson and to my niece Lou Mosley I give my boy Joe, a plain Silver waiter one Cottage Headstead one feather bed two Mattresses ~~silver~~ ~~padding~~ ~~that's~~ two pillows one Bolster my Bar or Center Table a Mahogany Attu Burro Wand robe & Marble top Wait Stand to my nephew James H. Mosley I give five hundred dollars in money, To Mary Mosley daughter of Joseph Mosley I give one thousand dollars in money one silver Easter Egg dozen silver Forks and four Volums of Shewen Houns to Elmerpect Jones, and I add her daughter I give one thousand dollars in money, and should Margant Jones marry, or die it is my will that the whole of the of one thousand dollars shall go to her daughter I add Jones free from the claims of any and ~~any~~ other person forever
