Troup County } of our Lord one thousand Eighteen
hundred and thirty seven.

I Nancy Dingler being sound in mind and memory doth Commit my soul and body into the hand of God and have this day made this my last will and testament to wit

I do give and bequeath to Matilda Smith one trunk - also I give unto Katherine Edwards one cover lid - also I give unto Henry Dingler one cover lid - also I give unto Mary Dingler the wife of John Dingler fifteen dollars - also I give unto William Dingler's heirs one dollar - also I give unto Samuel Dingler one dollar - then I give all the rest of my Estate unto my son Henry Dingler and daughters Sarah Chffman and Milly Tucker and Pheny Tucker and Katharine Edwards after my decease - all my estate to be equally divided between the five last mentioned - also I leave Jeremia^h Tucker and John Tucker my Executors to my will - if there should be any of the heirs dissatisfied they shall have none of my property
