

Mrs Nancy S. Jarvis Will

State of Georgia } The Last Will and Testament of
Franklin County } Nancy S. Jarvis

In the name of God. Amen.

Item 1st After the payment of my debts I bequeath the remain-
der of my estate as follows To my grand daughter Elizabeth
Picklen I give the Negv woman Dicy and her Children present
and future with this condition that as the children of Dicy
are supported by my Son John H H Colquitt I shall pay
to said John H H Colquitt fifty Dollars per annum for each Child
so long as such child is under eight years of age and to be supported
by said John as now from its birth I give Dicy and her Children
to said Elizabeth for her life & after her death to her Children
equally and as Elizabeth Picklen lives in a free state I empower
my Executor with the consent of Elizabeth Picklen to sell Dicy & her
children and herme over the proceeds of the sale in lieu of the
Negroes to be voted as she may direct in other property in the same
manner as I put the title of the negroes in this Will -

Item 2nd To my grand daughter Nancy John S. give one bed
and furniture To my Granddaughter Nancy Virginia
Colquitt I give one bed and furniture To my grand daughter
Mary Eliza Colquitt I give the Piano one bureau & bed
and furniture And to my grand daughter Josephine Colquitt
I give one wash stand & furniture.

Item 3rd To my Son and only surviving Child John H H Colquitt
I give the home and lot in LaFrange on which I live
and the Negroes Austin Matilda Patience and Child and
Lizzie and all other land and Negroes that I may own at my
death and all the house hold and Kitchen furniture
and all other property of every kind whether real or personal
or mixed and whosoever which I may own at the time
of my death. Item 4th I appoint my said Son John
H H Colquitt Executor of this Will and by the Execution of
this Will I revoke all made previously

In witness of all which I have hereto set my hand
and Seal & Published this as my will A.D. October 19th 1859

The foregoing will was read over to testatrix in our

& sealed & Executed as her will in our presence and
by us attested as witnesses in presence of Nancy S. Jarviss
this day 19th October 1859
