body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent and Christian like
manner and all my lawful debts to
be paid.

Item I will to my beloved wife

possession for her own proper use and benefit
to be at her disposal to be kept by her
without appraisement or sale for during
the term of her natural lifetime, also
all my bedding, house hold kitchen
furniture to be disposed of by her as
