 make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore
 made by me. —

- Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian
 like manner.
- " 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by
 my Executors herein after appointed.
- " 3rd I give and bequeath to my brother Edward Nagland a promissory
 note which I hold against him for about the sum of Four hundred
 and fifty dollars
- " 4th I desire and direct that the boy George about thirty years old
 (a slave) shall be valued by three disinterested persons and that
 my sister Jane Brewer Torcho shall take the boy George and pay to
 my brother Edward Nagland half his appraised value, that is
 to say, I give and bequeath the boy George to my sister Jane Brewer
 Torcho she paying over to my brother Edward Nagland half of
 his value, and the said money (half the value of the boy George) I
 give and bequeath to the said Edward Nagland and his children.
- " 5th I give and bequeath to Robert Bowman one hundred & fifty dollars.
- " 6th I give and bequeath to Sarah Bowman one hundred & fifty dollars.
- " 7th I hereby constitute and appoint John S. Nagland Executor of
 this my last will and testament this 15th day of July 1853
