 fore make and give publish and declare this to be
 my last will and testament that is to say First
 to my beloved Wife I give and bequeath one negro woman
 by the name of Orusilla also one negro man by the
 name of Peter also one Beasted Bess and furniture
 and am safe they to by heirs to do as they please
 with during her life and at her death except
 the negro man Peter who at her death is to belong
 to my Estate in addition to the above I give unto her
 and equal heirs with my Children of all the balance
 of my Estate that I may be possess of at my death
 I give and bequeath unto my Children to
 wit Cynthia Jones John S. Hall the Children of
 Sarah S. Hall Fidelity S. D. and the Children of my
 Daughter Cynthia Anderson to wit Elizabeth Anderson
 and William Anderson the execution to be put in
 the hands of a guardian such as the Court
 may see fit to appoint until the said Elizabeth
 and William become of age William Hall &
 Thomas Hall the Children of Robert Hall to
 wit William S. Hall his portion also to be put in
 the hands of a guardian such as the Court may
 appoint until they become of age or should
 here die before they become of age his portion
 to red it back to my Estate I give S. D. Hall
 Emily Eliza Hall Maria S. Edwards her mother
 I portion to her same to use as she fit all the
 remaining portion of my Estate both real and
 personal the property to be sold and equally divided
 among the above named legates and when
 alive. I make constitute and
 appoint my son John S. Hall and my beloved
 wife Cynthia Hall Executors and Executrix to
 this my last will and testament and as our
 County seems rare to be overruled by difficulty and
 financial depression I wish this property all
 to remain as much as it is my duty to do
 best In witness where of I have hereunto
 subscribed my name and affixed my seal this
 the twenty fifth day of March in the year of
 our Lord one thousand and Eight hundred and
 Eighty two

The within paper writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Robert Hall late of this County Deced was brate into Court this day by John R. Hall and Joshua S. Goffington and William S. Goffington two of the Witnesses thereto appearing before me on oath, that the same last aforesaid is the same and that he swears the same voluntarily and of his own accord that he was of sound mind at the time that they signed the same as Witnesses in his presents and in presence of each other at his request and that W. H. McMillin was present and signed the same as a Witness pursuant and subscribed before me this date above Joshua Goffington

Being desirous of disposing of my property to take effect after my death I Charles Sargent do hereby make my last will and Testament hereby revoking all wills & Testaments which I have heretofore made

Item 1st out of the debt which Joseph Sanderson owes me I want one half thereof to go to Sarah Ann Andison provided he does not pay it before my death & provided he pays it before my death I want her to have as much out of my property as one half of that amount comes to out of my property

Item 2nd all of my property besides that given in the first item I give devise and bequeath to Dorcas Andison for and during her life time and to and for her heirs and legitimate heirs and after her death to go to Sarah Ann Andison

Item 3rd I hereby nominate and appoint James H. Galloway Executor of this my last will and Testament my testimony of all which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 27 Day of July A.D. 1861
