 this as my last Will & Testament this the 18th day of June 1853

 mind and memory and that she executed the same freely and voluntarily
 that she signed and published the same in the presence of the witnesses
 and that we each attested the same as witnesses in the presence of the
 Testatrix and in the presence of each other and that such paper writing
 was then executed published and attested as it now appears in Court
 sworn to and subscribed in Open Court
