description whatever to my son in law William A. Patten of said County and State
hereby making him my sole Legatee. He is and has been to me as an affectionate and
affectional Son and as such I desire him to have whatever I shall leave
I now^{2nd} I also appoint my son William A. Patten Executor of this my last Will &
Testament. In Testimony whereof I have signed my hand & seal & published
this as my last Will & Testament this the 18th day of June 1853.

Rogers late of said County while in life to Wit on the 18th day of June last past
sign, seal, publish and declare the paper writing now presented as her
last Will and Testament that she has at the time of signing and disposing
mind and memory and that she executed the same freely and voluntarily
that she signed and published the same in the presence of the witnesses
and that we each attested the same as witness in the presence of the
testator and in the presence of each other and that such paper writing
was then executed published and attested as it now appears in Court

be and the same are hereby appointed to appraise said estate in terms
of the Law
