5th I give and bequeath and devise to my grand
 Daughter Martha E. Ray the sum of five Dollars
 in money

6th I give and bequeath and devise to my grand
 Daughter Theresa M. Wood 1 Feather Bed

7th I give and bequeath and devise to my son Rawland
 W. Hudson the Balance of Stock of Cattle and so the balance
 of my Stock of Hogs and all of my Pork or Bacon on hand
 also all of my Corn on hand also my Cotton on hand
 also the balance of my Lard and other Furniture

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I Have I give and bequeath and devise to Rawland W. Hudson my said all my entire Interest and Estate in the Estate of Richard Hudson deceased

I Have also appoint Rawland W. Hudson my Son my Executor to this my last will and testament

Hudson as a Codicil to her last will and testament of the 21 day of April Eighteen hundred and fifty five in the presence of the Subscribers who have signed here for the purpose of Mending the Codicil of this Special instance and request of said testatrix in her presence and in the presence of each other this 11 day of June 1858
