In the name of god amen
I Thomas Cameron of the
State of Georgia aforesaid
being in feeble heath but of sound & disposing
mind and memory do make and publish this my
last will & testament revoking all other wills made
by me heretofore

- Item 1st I will that all my just debts be paid together
with my funeral expenses
- Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Thomas Gipsom
and Son of my Daughter Amaritha one hundred
dollars the same to be kept at interest until he shall
of lawful age the same to be kept and controlled
by his Father or born Gipsom as his trustee
- Item 3rd I will that five Shares of my Rail Road Stock
in the Montgomery and West Point Rail Road
Company or the proceeds thereof for the first
five years after my death to be appropriated to
the use and benefit of the Creek Indian Mission
Cause
- Item 4th I will that the proceeds of five Shares of said
Rail Road Stock be appropriated for the first five
years after my death to the use and benefit of the
Baptist Church at Long Cane provided the same is
kept in the use of said Church and after the
expiration of said time the said ten Shares of
Rail Road Stock shall become a portion of my
Estate and Subject to division as the balance of my
Estate
- Item 5th I will that after my death my Executor Cause to
be appointed five Suitable Commissioners whose
duty it will be to meet and appraise and
lot off by lot or otherwise all of my effects
both real & personal Equally between my
four Children to wit. first giving to Joseph
Montgomery in trust for his wife Julia
Montgomery one fourth part to be kept and
used for her use during her natural
life and then go to her children second giving
to John S. Hill in trust for his wife Sarah
Hill one fourth part for her use during her
natural life and then to go to her children
and thirdly giving to Cusbourn Gipsom
in trust for his wife Amaritha Gipsom one
fourth part of said Effects to be kept for her
use and benefit during her natural life and
then to go to her children and fourthly giving to my Son
Benjamin S. Cameron the remaining fourth with
with the additional sum of one hundred dollars
to be kept by him as trustee for my grand Son
Thomson Cameron and Son of said Benjamin
at interest until he shall be of
lawful age

Item 6 It is my will and desire that my old servant
Mouran Barkary be set at liberty and be
allowed to select a home with any one of my children
that she may desire and a reasonable support
be kept for her and retained in the hands of my
Executors provided she should become afflicted
from any Cause

Item 7 I do appoint and constitute my son Benjamin
I Cameron my lawful Executor to conduct
and carry into effect this my last will and testament

Whereas I Thomas Cameron of County of Group
and State of Georgia have made my last will
& testament in writing bearing date in the Month
of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and fifty nine. in and by which
I have appointed my son Benjamin I Cameron
my sole Executor

Now therefore I do by this
my writing which I hereby declare to be a
Codicile to my said last will and testament
and to be taken as part thereof also appoint my
son in law John S Hill of the same County
and State Executor to act with my said son
Benjamin I Cameron Executor of my last will and
testament and lastly it is my desire that this
shall be annexed to and taken as part
of my last will & testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal the 11th day of September
1859 Thomas Cameron

Thomas Cameron in our presence and acknow-
ledged by him to each of us as a Codicile
to and part of his last will & testament
and we at his request and in his presence
have signed our names as witnesses hereto
this the Eleventh day of September in the year
of our Lord 1859

 Henry D Phillips Benj Sheppard John Evans
 and Wm R Davidson be and they are hereby
 appointed to make an inventory and
 appraisement of the rights and credits goods
 and chattels of said decd all of which being
 done letters testamentary were granted
 Oct 3rd 1859 Samuel Curtright Ordry
