I make and bequeath to my wife Georgia Ann during  
her life and widowhood all my estate real and personal  
for the benefit of her self and my Children subject  
to the limitations and conditions hereinafter mentioned

Item 1

as each of my Children shall reach the age of Twenty one  
years and in the case of the girls when they attain the  
age of marriage I will that the said Georgia Ann shall  
give to each Child so coming of age or marrying so much  
of my estate not exceeding 1 Child's part as can be spared  
from the first part and maintenance of her self and  
the remaining Children of which she is to be the  
sole judge and when such shall die or marry again  
in case of her marriage I will that the property be  
divided between her and the Children then and then alike  
she taking active part and in case of her death before marri-  
age I will that this property be divided equally among the  
Children and whenever a final division is made I  
desire that whatever property may have been previously given  
off to any Child shall be accounted for at its appearance  
whether at the time it was given off and all the property  
received by my daughters under this will shall be theirs for  
their own benefit and liberty free from all their debts and  
Contracts of their future husbands

Item 2

If the said Georgia Ann shall at any time during her wed-  
lockes think best for the benefit of the family to alter this  
form of any property left by me at my death either by  
exchange or by giving and reserving some share thereof  
free power to do so according to her best judgment  
in the premises

Item 3

I appoint my wife the sole Georgia Ann sole Exec-  
utor of this my last will and Testament  
until January next when I have bequeathed my lands thus  
21 day of October 1861 Thomas J. Bacon

1. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my Daughter the Mother  
 M. Eastman and Father Beale and her son

2. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my Daughter  
 Mahala Duke and Father Beale and her son

3. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my grand daughters  
 Mary Thru and Edgar Miller each five Dollars in  
 Money to be left in the hands of my Son Rawdon W. Bullock  
 to be paid to them as the same of age

4. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my grand  
 Daughter Susan A. Miller the sum of five Dollars in money

5. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my grand  
 Daughter Martha E. Ray the sum of five Dollars in money  
 in memory

6. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my grand  
 Daughter Maria W. Wood & Father Beale

7. Item I give and bequeath and devise to my Son Rawdon  
 W. Bullock the Banker of Stock of Cattle etc & the balance  
 of my Stock of 16000 and all of my Pork or bacon on hand  
 also all of my Cans in hand also my Cotton in hand  
 also the balance of my household and Kitchen furniture
