The Last Will & Testament of Thomas Smalley Esq.

In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Smalley of the County of Trumbull
and State of Connecticut being of sound mind and memory and thanks be to
Almighty God for his mercy. Do this tenth of March in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two make and Ordain this my
last will and testament in manner and form following (that is to say)
First I give to my son Thomas M. Smalley my Negro Man Abram more than an
equal share unto the rest of my heirs.

Second I give to my daughter Nancy Smalley my negro Woman Sarah and her
two children Miles, Harriet and Emily and her future increase and then
an equal share with the rest of my heirs.

Third I give to my son John Smalley an equal share with the rest of my heirs with
the exception above mentioned of Thomas and Nancy.

Fourth I give to my daughter Nancy (Harratt) an equal share with the rest of my
heirs with the exception above mentioned. And hereby make and Ordain
Thomas M. Smalley her Curator to act and manage her part
of my estate I give to her for her own use to be disposed of by her as she
see fit and not to be subject to her husband or at his disposal in any
way whatsoever.

Fifth I give to my daughter Lucy Harrelleth an equal share with the rest
of my heirs with the exception above named. I give it to her and her
children exclusively for their use and benefit and not to be subject
to her husband or the payment of any of his debts. And I do hereby
make and Ordain Robert M. Smalley her Curator to act and do for
her so far respects her part of my estate.

Sixth I give to my daughter Elizabeth Atkins an equal share with the
rest of my heirs with the above exception of Thomas & Nancy. But there is to be paid
and eighty five dollars to Anne out of her part of my estate for her son Peter
Smalley whom I have given her already.

Seventh I give to my son Sam'l M. Smalley Orphans Christian (now) William F. Smalley
Amelia A. Smalley Elyza A. Smalley now Eliza B. Johnson and Ann Farley
Sam'l M. Smalley Martha A. Smalley and Lucia Anna Smalley an equal share
with the rest of my heirs with the exception above mentioned to be equally divided
among them.

Eighth I give to my Daughter Penelope Barnard an equal share with the rest

of my heirs except Thomas J. ~~Frank~~
Borth I make and Ordain my sons John Simmley and Thomas Mc. Simmley Exec
of this my last will in trust for the intents and purposes in this my last
testament.
