Troup County Wills 1832-1848

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Georgia Troup County. The last will and Testament of Thomas Worthey of the State and County aforesaid, my first desire is that after I am dead, that I shall be decently buried, secondly, that all my Just debts be paid, Thirdly, that my Carriage and pair of horses is hereby bequeathed to my beloved wife Jane Worthey, Fourthly, that all the balance of my property be equally divided between my beloved wife Jane Worthey, Perry Jackson Worthey, Joseph Shelton Worthey, Henry Thompson Worthey, Samuel Davis Worthey, and my youngest son who is yet without any name, and my further Will and desire is that Jane Worthey and Benjamin P. Robinson be Executors and Executrix of the above describing Will, this the third day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.
