form following that is to say- I will that all
my just debts be paid out of my Estate -
Secondly - I will that my property of whatever
kind either real or personal be kept together &
under the management of my beloved wife Eliza
P. Williams for the use and benefit of herself &
my children hereinafter named so long as my
said wife shall remain my widow and in the
event of her marriage all my effects both real
and personal to become the subject of immediate
distribution according to the laws of Georgia
between my said wife and my children Mary
W. Williams, Mary Annas Williams, Georgiana
Florida Williams, Vera W. Williams, as well
as any and all other children which may
hereafter be born to me of my said wife
Eliza P. Williams and in the event of the
marriage or arriving at full age of any of
my children aforesaid my will & desire
is that my said property shall so far
become the subject of distribution & division
as for the child so marrying or becoming of
full age to receive his or her distributive
share of my said Estate & for each of them
so marrying or coming of full age to be
dealt with in like manner - Finally
my will and desire is that my entire

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family shall be maintained & my children educated in a style and after a manner suitable to their condition in life out of my Estate and without any charge upon either of their distributive shares of my Estate.

Fifthly - I do hereby constitute nominate & appoint my dear wife Eliza P. Williams Executrix & my trust friend Dr Andrews Battle Executor of this my last will & Testament and do also hereby revoke all former wills by me made.
