last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills made by me at any time heretofore
made

First I command my heirs to pay the same if and my body I desire to be buried with
my family at Tom Corners in said County and my personal estate I dispose of as
follows I wish my families graves together with my own to be decently pointed out
all under the same enclosure as soon as convenient after I am then de-
parted with them and the expenses and liabilities of the same paid together with all other
expenses and liabilities that have or may have accrued concerning my business
generally & I further wish my effects that is my little property to be sold on
a credit of Twelve months to the highest bidder after the above is so ordered
all paid and settled it is my wish that my brother John Richards Childsen to
Wm. Williams, Mary & Rebecca shall have the remainder of the money when
then come of Lawfull age whatever their may be, It is also my wish that
William Boyd and William Mc McCutchen and I do have up to date both or each
of them Executors of my last Will and Testament and also the ^{Benefit} ~~Benefit~~ for the above
named Children be that they may be the beneficiaries of the same as acknowledged
above, In witness whereof I the said William Richards here to this my
Will consisting of one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this the
Fifteenth 1856
