

Will of H. J. Bluckworth

I H. J. Bluckworth of said State and County, being of sound mind and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all others heretofore made.

1. I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner, suitable to my circumstances in life.
2. I desire that all my just debts be paid by my executor herein after named and appointed.
3. I give bequeath and devise to my wife Mary Bluckworth all the property both real and personal that I may die possessed of the rents and profits thereunto to be used for her support during her natural life.
4. I give devise and bequeath to my son A. L. Bluckworth the remainder interest in all the property which I have given to my wife by terms of this my will, provided he shall take care of her and see that neither I nor my said wife shall not lack for care and nursing as long as we and either of us shall live.
5. I hereby constitute John C. Collins the sole executor of this my last will and testament.
