last Will and Testament hereby revoking
any and all Wills and Testaments I may
have heretofore made

Item 1st I desire and direct my executor herein
after nominated and appointed to have
my body buried in a Christian-like
manner at Antioch Church - home in said
County and State and in a manner
suitable to my station in life and my
Soul I trust will take its flight to the
ding and merciful God who gave it being

Item 2nd I hereby nominate and appoint my
beloved son Farkis Lewis my lawful
executor to carry into effect this my last
Will and Testament and having full
faith in his honesty and integrity I
release him from the duty of making
and giving bond to carry into effect
the same and from the further duty of
making to the Ordinary of said State
and County annual returns of his acts
and doing as such Executor

Item 3rd I direct my heretofore appointed
and nominated executor at my death to
pay all of my honest debts if any exist

Item 4th To my my beloved children hereinafter
named I give and bequeath all of my
property both personal and real
consisting of parts of lots of land No's
119 and 120 in the 9th Dist and 1st Sec
of said State and County it being the
place whereon I now reside together

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with what personal property I own at my death to viz Thomas Miller Lewis Sordis Lewis Mauda Miller Harriet G. Garon Tiney Adaline Sedford Alfred S. Lewis

"Item 5" I direct and desire that the bodily heirs of Nancy C. Mulvey be given and have paid to them a child's part of my Estate it being the part my daughter Nancy C. Mulvey would have heirs if she had been living

"Item 6" I desire and direct that my granddaughter Sarah Ann Hamby daughter of George Lewis be paid a child's part of my estate the same being what my son George Lewis would have heirs had he been living

"Item 7" I direct and desire that my granddaughter Mary Jane Rogers daughter of Rufus Lewis be paid a child's part of my estate the same being what my son Rufus Lewis would have heirs if he had been living

"Item 8" I desire and direct that all of my wearing clothes at my death be given and divided among my three daughters Harriet G. Garon Mauda Miller and Tiney Adaline Sedford In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 9th day of Sept 1882
