Thus I give bequeath and devise to my son
Charles Rich the following property to wit
part of Lot of Land No 62 in the 10th dist - I do
not that part of said Lot - sit deeply by me
to Elizabeth A Chestnut by me on the 9th day
of August, 1888. It being the west part
of said Lot of Land containing ninety
five acres more or less sit lying
and being in the county of Union
State Sec 22. I give bequeath and devise to
my sons Solomon H. Andrew &
Martin V Rich the following
property to wit, lot of Land No 90
in the 10th dist - I do it - lying and
being in Union County. Each an
equal intent to all of said lot
of Land, Except that portion thereof
by me to Johna H. Chestnut. With
land bounds describing in said Deed
in full sample

Thus I give, I give bequeath and devise
to my Daughters Nancy and Mary
Rachel and my sons John M. Withers
W. and William W. Rich the following
property to wit - all my interest in
lot of Land No 51 in the 10th dist & it
containing 53 acres more or less
with and bounds describing in a
Deed made by me to John M. Withers
for two thirds of said lot - all my
interest too lot of Land No 57 in the
10th dist - and I do it - being the intent
to Land and one half intent in all
minerals of said lot of Land
said Land lying and being in
the county of Union. Each an
equal intent in said Deed in full sample

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Then fourth I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah Rich if living the sum of Ten hundred and
 five of DOLLARS and the full of all claims
 against my Estate, and my Executor hereinafter
 appointed is hereby directed to pay said ten
 Dollars out of my money in his hands
 arising from any sales made by him
 of my Effects herein mentioned

Then fifth I hereby direct my Executor to
 pay Elizabeth A. Whistler her private share
 of my Effects ~~Effects~~ in his hands if any
 in share in afterwards provided as I give
 her her part of my real Estate in a
 deed made by me to her on the 9th day of
 August - 1888

Then sixth I hereby direct that all my just
 and legal debts be paid by my Executor
 hereinafterwards appointing out of any
 my money arising from any sales
 made from my real Estate or personal
 property I may be possessed of at my
 desire

Then seventh I direct and request that
 my body be buried in decent and
 Christian like manner and the
 expenses thereof be paid by my said
 Executor

Then eighth I hereby appoint my friend
 Jonathan C. Waller Executor of this
 my last will and testament and said
 Executor is hereby directed to sell all
 of my real Estate and personal
 property, that I may be possessed of at
 my desire not being disposed off
 by my will at private or public sale
 in the way I think best and that he proceed
 without giving bond and security to dispose
 of my Effects as herein directed

Then ninth I hereby authorize and request
 my heirs herein mentioned that
 they may agree to pay all my

legal and just-leave out of my will
not disposed of in this my will and
dispose of the same paying out and complying
with all the terms in this my last will and
testament and make a equal division of the
remainder in money and property
then left. In case my heirs agree as authorized
in this will, I release my Executor
from all duties and requirements
herein mentioning,
