Fourth - I desire that one child's part of my said Estate be equally divided among the heirs of Martha A. Loya and deed - the said Elizabeth my Wife her interest - to be equal to one child's part of said Estate -

Fifthly I hereby constitute and appoint my Son Thomas M. Hughes and Milfred H. Hansby Executors of this my last Will and Testament -
