apart my family and myself that I should
make a disposition of the property with

so therefore make this my last will and
testament, making all other heretofore
made by me.

1st I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid without delay by my ex^{ors} andutors here-
inafter appointed as I am unwilling my
creditors should be delayed in their pay^{ment}.

2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife and
my daughter Julia Ann Elizabeth Coffee all
of my cows and yearlings, also all my home-
hold and kitchen furniture, also all my
farming utensils, also one bay mare and
one two year old brown colt and mare and in
way of all without reserve or limitation.

3rd I give and bequeath all the rest of my
property both real and personal to the rest of my
children to be equally divided between A. H.
Patton my son and W. H. Patton my son, and
Elmirey Groves my daughter, Mary Brown
my daughter and Emily Jane Kurtz, my daughter
and Mary Malinda Lewis my daughter.

4th I hereby constitute and appoint W. H. Patton,
E. H. Patton and my son A. H. Patton ex^{ors} of this
my last will and testament this April 15th 1891.
