In the Name of God Amen!

I George Howell, of the County aforesaid, in view of the

closeness of death, do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament.

I command my soul to the Mercy of Him who gave it; And
my body to the Earth in decent Christian burial: And of my worldly

substance I make the following disposition -

Item. I give to my beloved wife Christian Howell the use of my old
Black Coach Jepet & his wife Serena, and the one fifth part
of all my Estate both Real & Personal of every kind, to be kept by
her during her natural life under the following qualifications, viz:
that is to keep it together with my Children, property that remain
together until my youngest Child comes of age; And if she
should choose to marry her Husband not to have the same
till she gives good bond & security to my Executor, or Executor
to return the same to my Executor, or Executor upon the happening
of the death of my said wife

Item. My will and desire is that my Children alive at the death of my
said wife, & their Children, (Should any of my Children be dead & leave
Children) have, share & share alike, the property hereinbefore given
to my said wife, my said grand Children only to have their Parents share

Item. I wish all my property both Real & personal to remain together
as it is under the direction & Management of my Executors subject
to the divisions hereinbefore mentioned, And my wife and Children
to receive from the proceeds of the same board, Clothing & Schooling
such as a prudent economy would justify - And whenever any
surplus arises from the sale of the Crop let my Executor, or
Executor loan out the same on good security -

Item. Whenever my daughter Mary come of age or marry I give them (subject
to the first mention'd) an equal share of my ^{Personal} property
except & save to the right of the house, both & Kitchen furniture, my Executor,
or Executor to execute a bill to my said daughter or their husband,
so as to secure said equal share to my said daughter during their
natural life against any & every liability whatever to be contracted
by their husband or any one else

Item. In making said equal share of property herein mentioned I
include my wife & four children, making now five parts, when
one gets their part leaving four and so on down

Item. To my Sons come of age I give them the one fifth part of all
my Estate both Real & Personal without Reserve

Item. I wish my Children as they come of age or marry to receive such
household and kitchen furniture as the rest of my family can well

spare, my Executor, taking a Receipt for it and estimating it Valued
in the same —

Item - Should one of my Children die before receiving their share of my Estate
it is my will that their share be equally divided among the rest of
my Children (and grand Children in case one be dead leaving Children
to inherit their deceased Parents part), and to be divided in such
way as will be most convenient to my Executors & the well being of the Estate.

Item - Until my youngest Child becomes of age, it is my will I desire
that my Children as they Marry or comes of age receive from my Executors
the use of the one fifth part of my land to be taken from the Smith
and Parry lots, and to be selected by my Executors or Executor in
such way as to give them the same in as good & Convenient a place
as they may be able to do taking ~~into~~ Consideration the other interests
provided the same shall be occupied by my said Children & not
by a Tenant or Tenants, and my said Children shall so use said
one fifth part as to take proper care of the same both in Cultivating
and Keeping up the fences —

Item - When my youngest Child may be of age, I wish my Estate
divided equally between my said wife Christian & my four Children
(or their Children if one or more be dead) my said daughters & wife
to receive their part in the same way & under the same Circumstances
as I have given them the personal property hereinbefore mentioned
to be divided in such way as may suit a Majority either by sale
or otherwise —

Item - Upon the death of my wife I hereby give her interest in my Estate
to my Children & Grand Children if any of my Children be dead
To be divided share & share alike —

Item - I have heretofore agreed, and now give to the Trustees of the Methodist
Episcopal Church that are appointed or that may hereafter be appointed
for the Church called Antioch near my house ~~upon~~ acres of land
lawned said Church; the line to commence on the Public road
and at a point South of the Church so as to run East upon the
said road and take in the lawn yard some ten or fifteen steps,
to continue East so as to pass the lawn yard, then around the
Church so as to include the ~~upon~~ acres & embrace the Church &
lawn yard & have a good and open way to the Church upon
the road —

Item - I wish my Servant Booker sold on a credit of twelve months
to raise Money to pay my debts, and my Executors to take small
notes and good security —

I hereby nominate and appoint my friends
Robert Dinnerton and William Crawford Executors of

by last Will & Testament.
