Upson County 3 I Frances Holloway of the County & State aforesaid, do make
and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner & form following

First, I resign my Soul in the hands of Almighty God: and my body
I Commit to the Earth, to be buried at the discretion of my Executors
hereinafter named, and my worldly Estate I give & devise as follows

First, I give and devise to my Son Patrick G. Holloway the following
Negro W^{ch}. Isaac a Negro Man, May his wife and her two Children
Ellen and Ezekiel

Also I give and devise to my daughter Edney Edwards, full
a Negro Woman

Also, I give and devise to my Grand Son Edward S Holloway Son
of Edward S. Holloway dec^d, a Negro boy named Burwell; provide
my said Grand Son Edward S. Holloway should die before he arrives
to the age of twenty one year or without a lawful heir, then said
Negro so willed sh^{al} be sold, and the money arising from the
sale thereof to be equally divided between my Son Paul Holloway's Children

Also, I give and devise to my Son Paul Holloway's Children the lot
of Land whereon I now live, it being lot No. Ninety four (94) lying
in the tenth district of former Monroe, now Upson County containing
by estimation Two hundred two and one half acres more or less
with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging

And it is further my Will and desire that the balance of my
property consisting of all my house hold and Kitchen furniture,
all my stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, and every thing else
not Willed of whatsover it may consist in to be sold and after
paying my Just Debts to be divided as follows. One equal share
to go to Daughter Elizabeth Garland's Children, One equal share
to my Daughter Frances Goodie's Children, One equal share to
my Daughter Abby Edwards' Children, One equal share to my
Daughter Louisa Stafford's Children and one equal share to my
Daughter Edney Edwards' Children

And I do hereby appoint Patrick G. Holloway executor to
this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former
Wills by me made
