

In the name of God. Amen.

I Henry Garland Senior of the State of Georgia and County of Upson being in good health of sound and disposing mind & Memory do this thirteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty seven, make Ordain & Combitute this my last will & Testament.

I bequeath first my body to the Earth from whence it came to be decently interred at the discretion of my friends, and my Soul to God who gave it, hoping & believing it will be everlastingly saved through Jesus Christ.

In the second place I bequeath to my wife Mary Garland Vina a negro girl (Slave) about fifteen years of age and her increase & my Carriage as all her part.

In the third place I bequeath to my Son Patrick Garland a negro boy (Slave) about fifteen years of age & all of his part.

In the fourth place I bequeath to my Son Henry Garland, Eazy a negro girl (Slave) age about thirteen years & Silva a girl about five years old & their increase to have and to hold during his natural life, after which it is my will & intention that the said two Negroes (viz) Eazy & Silva and their increase shall go to my four grand Children (viz) Felix, Frances, John & Caroline (they being the four first Children of my Son Henry Garland) and to be equally divided as all of his part.

In the fifth place I bequeath to my Son Bradford Garland a negro woman named Lucy about forty years of age & all that part or parcel of Land lying South of a line commencing at a Hickory Corner on the West Side of the lot of Land wherein I now live & being number fifty two (52) in the tenth district of Upson formerly now Upson County & running a Crop fence East to Red Oak which I have marked, from thence to a Poplar tree at the head of the Spring branch near my Lot fence, thence down the branch to the line as all his part.

In the sixth place I bequeath to my Son William J. Garland, Charles a negro Man (Slave) about twenty two years of age and all that part of Lot of Land number fifty two (52) bounded as follows commencing at the North West Corner of said Lot number fifty two (52) and running South along Bridge, lot to a Hickory Corner which I have made near a Crop fence, which runs near East, thence along said fence to a Red Oak near the edge of the woods & thence to a Poplar tree at the lot fence near the head of my Spring

branch, thence down said branch to the original line, it being the southern part of said lot of land fifty two as all of his part.

In the Seventh place I bequeath to my Daughters (Viz) Mary Canick, Sarah Hadaway now dead her four children Thomas, Hadaway & Eliza Hadaway in her place, Elizabeth Perdue now dead her four children in her place Viz. Henry Perdue, Isom Perdue - Jane & Sarah Perdue - Mary Ann Collier, Lucy E. Roberson and Nancy Roberts the negro woman named Jilda & her increase together with all the residue of my Estate both real & personal not herein disposed of to be sold & equally divided among them my Daughters & Grand Children as above named -

Having now disposed of my property I now appoint & bequeath my Son William C. Garland my Sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament -
