I Isaac Jackson of the County & State aforesaid being, weak in body but sound Mind and Memory, for divers Causes and Considerations, me hereunto moving, do make this my last Will and Testament

First I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Jackson during, her natural life, the Land I live on together with all the appurtenances, attached thereunto, also two Negroes, To wit, Minerva a woman and Robert a man; all my stock of Cattle, two Horses and all my household and kitchen furniture and a sufficiency of plantation tools for the farm, and provisions for the family for the next ensuing year consisting of Corn, fodder, pork &c. My three youngest Children John F. Jackson and Turner J. Jackson and Mary J. Jackson I wish to remain with my beloved Wife till they are Twenty one year of age and be furnished by her at the time they are free or get married with House hold and saddle, bed and furniture as good as I gave my other Children when they left me, the balance of my property I wish equally divided among all my Children the negroes to be sold among my Children & not to go out of the family the property given to my beloved Wife at her death to be equally divided among all my Children

And I do hereby ordain and appoint and do by these presents make ordain & appoint Lemuel M. Galtin of the County & State aforesaid Executor to this my last Will and Testament to execute & carry the same in full effect
