

Georgia S In the name of God Amen. I James Blalock of the  
Upson County, Georgia and State aforesaid considering the uncertainty of this mortal  
life and being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be Almighty God  
for the same, do make and publish this my last will and testament, in man-  
ner and form following, viz.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife O. D. A. Blalock all my estate  
both real and personal during her life, or widowhood, to dispose of and give to the  
children as she may think proper, appraising the same and keeping an account  
thereof, and in case she should marry she is to take a child's part, the bal-  
ance of the property except the land to be equally divided among my heirs  
after giving those who have not received any part of my estate an equal amount  
with those who have, except Joseph F. Wills whose part I give and bequeath  
unto my beloved Grand Daughter Anna Wills and in case she should die without  
a surviving heir the property to return to the estate and equally divided among  
the heirs; and if any of my heirs should die leaving no heir the property  
to return to the estate and divided among the surviving heirs; and I further  
give and bequeath unto my sons all my lands to be equally divided  
between them; and furthermore I give and bequeath unto each of my sons a horse  
bridle and saddle extra, and I hereby appoint my beloved wife O. D. A. Blalock  
and such one of my sons as she may choose as my sole executors and  
Guardians of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former  
Wills by me made, —
