I Larkin Bass of the County and State aforesaid do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. My soul I Commend to Almighty God my worldly substance I dispose of as follows:

Item: I wish all my just debts paid as soon as convenient after my decease and, from the proceeds of what ^{may} be due me by account if the amount be sufficient, in the event that a sufficiency is not raised from said proceeds to pay my debts I wish a sufficient portion of the property hereinafter given to my wife to be sold to pay the balance of my debts she having the right to point out for this purpose what property she pleases.

Item: I give unto my children Mary William, Julia Louisa, and Charles Henry, my negro boy Jack about sixteen years old, my negro boy Richard about fourteen years of age also my three negroes now in the possession of my mother in Warren County, and left me in my Father's will, viz, Lewis about twenty six years of age, Penny his wife and their Child Francis. I desire the property named in this Item to be entirely under the control & for the benefit of my wife & Children till my Children become of age or marry, when these restrictions, viz, as each child may come of age or marry, I wish her or him to have her or his equal portion given to him or such equitable & just plan as my Executors may then think best.

Item: I give to my wife Mary Bass my negro girl Caroline about sixteen years of age, my boy Lark, formerly called Stinson about _____ years of age my house & lot in Thomaston, whereon I now reside with all and singular the rights and appurtenances therunto belonging in any way whatever, my interest in my Father's estate not otherwise disposed of, and all the rest of my estate (not herein otherwise disposed of) both real & personal of whatever kind it may be.

Item: I appoint Obadiah C. Gibson to settle my accounts and pay off my debts.
Item: I nominate and appoint my wife Mary Bass, and William Shivers Executors and Executor of this my Last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty third day of August 1833
